Write them down in your notebook along with their meanings, synonyms (similar words), and antonyms (opposite words).</p> <p><b>Ques.3 The "Silent Letter" Hunt</b> Create a list of 10 words that have silent letters (like K in Knife). For each word, write a creative sentence that clearly shows you know the word's meaning.
